### **COVID-19 Pandemic – Stay & Play COVID Agreement**

- I agree to follow the health and safety direction of the Manager and nursery staff whilst attending the Stay & Play session and understand that failure to do so may result in my party being asked to leave.
- I understand that my child(ren) continues to be my responsibility throughout the Stay & Play session.
- I agree to submit my full name, email address and contact telephone number for the purpose of engaging with Track and Trace\* if there was to be a positive case at the Stay & Play session.
- I agree to NOT attend if I or any member of my household is displaying any symptoms\*\* or has tested positive for COVID-19 in the 10 days prior to the Stay & Play session.
- Should I or a member of my household display any symptoms\*\* or test positive for COVID in the 48 hours AFTER the Stay & Play session, I understand I have a responsibility to notify the nursery immediately.
- I agree to refrain from parking in the school staff car park unless I require use of an accessible parking space (*which can be arranged by counting the nursery prior to the stay and play session*).
- I agree to wash my hands and that of my child(ren) thoroughly upon arrival and departure and before and after eating at the Stay & Play session.
- I understand that this is an outdoor event and that whilst children under 5 are exempt from the numbers allowed at a parent and child group, that we have a cap of 15 children over 5 and adults. I agree that I will not bring more people than is absolutely necessary to the Stay & Play session.
- I agree to bring a face covering to protect the wider community in the event that we are indoors at any time or that I am less than 2m from somebody else whilst outside (unless I am medically exempt). I will endeavour to maintain a social distance of 2m from other adults and children other than those in my party.
- I understand that any food I bring to nursery is for the consumption of my household only and that any rubbish will be taken home with me.
- I understand that if my child needs to be changed whilst at the Stay & Play session, nursery staff will direct me to the location of our changing facilities. I will wear a mask whilst inside and thoroughly wipe down mats and surfaces after use and dispose of nappies in the appropriate bin.

\*Graffham Nursery is obliged to report any confirmed cases of COVID-19 at nursery to the local health authority and Ofsted. Similarly, the local health authority will contact us if they become aware of a confirmed case who has been in contact with the nursery. We will always listen to and act upon advice given by the local health authority in a timely manner. More information on the Test and Trace system can be found here:
